I was so concerned about possible EMF interference that I moved my water softener and well pump control/bladder tank and tried to install the HydroSmart Household unit, by itself for the best possible performance. Big question is whether it works.

Absolutely!!!

Here is what I have found thus far. I did hook my water softener back up per Paul's recommendation. He just said the first 3-4 weeks the water might have "stuff" in it. It was an easy re-pipe for me so I just hooked it back up.

The day I installed, I took a shower about midnight before going to bed. HydroSmart had been installed about 4 hours. I have always had a little iron stain on the shower head outlets. Out of curiosity I took my thumb and rubbed the shower head. Any stain or mineral deposit that was previously build up, just came off. I really couldn't believe it.

It makes soaps and shampoos lather up so much more. My wife loves it because she can get shampoos and conditioners out of her hair faster.

Bottom line is that she is happy.

Within 24 hours my shop ice machine plugged up with some debris that was broken free by the HydroSmart. Cleaned out the debris and the ice machine works great and the ice is much clearer.

Our water out of the tap tastes great.

Less soap scum in the showers.

I have not gotten a chance yet but I will disconnect my Reverse Osmosis unit. I can't tell the difference now between it and the tap water.

I plan to bypass the water softener in another week or two to see what happens.

It is still kind of early to tell on the irrigation side since we have gotten some rain. And I just turned off my Rid O'Rust system and will monitor whether I see any staining.

I did buy a TriField Meter that tests Magnetic, Electric, and Radio Fields. This helped me decide on the location of installation.

It is just a little handheld but you would need to use it to verify a good spot for installation. Within minutes you will know.

Hooking up the HydroSmart is very easy. Planning the re-piping or moving around of equipment is the challenge.
